Ella Clarke Nuite is probably the best advertisement for the positive health effects of the product she continues to produce and sell, 40 hours a week. In fact, she remembers her family's excitement when President William Howard Taft declared Windsor Spring Water to be his favorite. In October, the 100-year-old Nuite was honored as America's Oldest Worker for 2004 by Experience Works. Now running the business, located in Hephzibah, Ga., with her grandson, Nuite handles the bookkeeping, answers the phone, oversees required testing of the water and conducts retail business at the plant. In her spare time, she is also landlord of nine homes she has purchased and renovated over the years.

Nuite was one of 53 older workers honored by the Experience Works Prime Time Awards Program.
